



Community of Practice Supervision in Education by Educators

Membership Criteria

Advocate and Supervisor Members:

- will have QTS and/or significant experience as an educator
- are committed to continuous development related to their professional practice
- promote the practice of supervision in education via the framework adopted by the Community of Practice
- contribute to the development of supervision in education by collaborating to support the mission of the Community of Practice
- are invited to make an annual contribution to cover membership admin, website and social media content, and hosting

Members who are practising supervisors will also:

- have participated in training **or** professional development to become a supervisor, which included experiential practice **and** which has developed their skills, knowledge and experience
- work in a manner consistent with the ethics and framework adopted by the group
- receive regular supervision on their supervision from a trained supervisor
- have a supervision policy and/or contract
- have liability insurance

Every member will be invited to decide if they wish to retain their membership at the start of every academic year. All members will receive a badge stating their membership as an advocate or supervisor member of CoPSiEbE. This badge can be used on their website, email, social media or promotional materials. Every year the badge will be updated. When members relinquish their membership, they must relinquish their use of the badge.
